

**Angeles Crest 100 Mile Endurance Run  
Runner's Race Drop Contract**

I \_\_\_\_\_ am an Official AC100 Race Entry and in event that I need to drop from the Race, I agree to notify Run Official at the Checkpoint that I am dropping from the Race and turn in my Medical Wristband to the Run Official at the Checkpoint where I am dropping, prior to my exit from the Race.

There will be a "large coffee can" on the food table at each Checkpoint with the "Checkpoint Name" and "Medical Band Drop Can" labeled on the side. If you cannot find a Run Official, cut the medical band off and place the band inside the fluorescent orange can before you leave the race.

Runners cannot drop out at the Kratka Ridge, Pajarito, or Glenwood. Highway Crossing. Runners must notify Run Official at the next Checkpoint and turn in their Medical Wristband.

**If you drop out, leave the race with your medical band and we cannot locate you. We will assume you are lost and notify Search & Rescue that we cannot account for a runner. Search & Rescue will looking for you.**

Failure to notify Race Official and turn-in my Medical Wristband will make me ineligible for future AC100 events and could make me responsible for reimbursement of Search and Rescue Team and helicopter use expenses.

**I have read this contract and understand it. If I drop out, I will not leave the race with the Medical Band, under any circumstance.** (Three runners that dropped, left the 2001 race without turning in their Medical Bands. S & R spent half a day looking for them! When we found out the dropped runners left without turning in their Medical Bands, S & R was mad!)
